

## ANALYSE OF FOREIGN CONTRIBUTION RECEIPTS IN 2006-07

During the year 2006-07, 19,011 associations reported receipt of foreign contribution amounting to Rs. 12,289.63 crores. Among the associations, which have reported receipt of foreign contribution, Ranchi Jesuits, Jharkhand received the highest amount of foreign contribution (Rs. 621.34 crores) followed by Santhome Trust of Kalyan, Mumbai, Maharashtra (Rs. 332.86 crores), Sovereign order of Malta, Delhi (Rs. 300.79 crores), World Vision of India, Tamil Nadu (Rs. 256.06 crores) and North Karnataka Jesuit Educational and Charitable Society Karnataka (Rs. 229.55 crores).

During the year, 147 associations received foreign contribution in excess of Rs. 10 crores, 169 associations between Rs. 5 and Rs. 10 crores, 1343 associations between Rs. 1 crore and Rs. 5 crores, and the remaining 17,352 below Rs. 1 crore. Out of 19,011 associations, 7,430 have reported nil receipt of foreign contribution. The receipt of foreign contribution by 25 major recipient associations is given in Annex – 1.

An analysis of foreign contribution received in various States/Union Territories indicates that Tamil Nadu reported the highest receipt of foreign contribution (Rs. 2,244.25 crores) followed by Delhi (Rs. 2,186.65 crores), Andhra Pradesh (Rs. 1,211.04 crores), Maharashtra (Rs. 1,195.45 crores) and Karnataka (Rs. 1077.12 crores). The State / Union Territory wise details on receipt of foreign contribution, are shown in Annex – 2.

The details of number of associations reporting receipts of foreign contribution and the amount of foreign contribution received by them during the year in following 15 major recipient States / Union Territories are as under:

An analysis of the data indicates the following five major recipient Districts in the country:

- (i) Chennai (Rs. **928.77** crores)
- (ii) Mumbai (Rs. **891.26** crores)
- (iii) Ranchi (Rs. **653.29** crores)
- (iv) Bangalore (Rs. **628.47** crores)
- (v) Kolkata (Rs. **338.73** crores)

The details in respect of the top 25 recipient districts in the country are shown at Annex-3.

#### **Details in respect of foreign donors and foreign donor countries**

The list of foreign donors is headed by the Misereor, Postfach, Germany (Rs. 1243.52 crores) followed by World Vision International, USA (Rs. 469.20 crores) Fundacion Vincente Ferrer, Spain (Rs. 399.45 crores) A.S.A Switzerland (Rs. 301.55 crores), and Liason Office of the Dalai Lama for Japan, Japan (Rs. 236.76 crores). The details in respect of top 25 foreign donors are shown in Annex – 4.

The five major donor countries are USA (Rs. 2971.29 crores), Germany (Rs. 1648.75 crores), UK (Rs. 1425.43 crores), Switzerland (Rs. 605.88.crores) and the Italy (Rs. 487.97 crores). The donor country-wise details are shown in Annex – 5.

#### **Analysis of The Last Three Years' Data**

From the analysis of the data for the last three years i.e. from 2004-05 to 2006-07, it emerges that:

- a) United States of America has been the top donor country.
- b) Miseroer Postfech, Germany has contributed the maximum amount of foreign contribution as a donor organization.
- c) The state of Tamil Nadu has received the largest amount of foreign contribution.
- d) Among the Districts, Chennai has received the highest amount of foreign contribution.
- e) Among the recipient associations, Ranchi Jesuits, Jharkhand received the highest amount of foreign contribution.
- f) Among the standard purposes, the highest amount of foreign contribution was utilized for Establishment expenses.

A comparative analysis of receipt and utilization of foreign contribution is illustrated in Charts 1 to 8.
